Joost Sliepenbeek appointed CFO of Van Gansewinkel Groep

Effective today, Joost Sliepenbeek has been appointed CFO of Van Gansewinkel Groep. Mr Sliepenbeek succeeds Rob de Fluiter Balledux, who is moving to AVR as part of the sale of AVR to Cheung Kong Infrastructure.

Mr Sliepenbeek (1963) previously held the position of chairman of the board of C1000 and a seat on the board of Jumbo Groep Holding. Before that he was chief financial officer of C1000, which was taken over by Jumbo in 2012.

Mr Sliepenbeek spent most of his career (1994-2007) working at Koninklijke Ahold N.V in various financial management positions, including as chief financial officer of Albert Heijn and chief accounting officer at Ahold. He was appointed CFO of HEMA in 2007, and moved to C1000 in 2009.
