Othman Benjelloun Touimi wins 2017 Pierre Faure Prize

Othman Benjelloun Touimi has been awarded the 2017 Pierre Faure Prize by the École Polytechnique Foundation in Paris (France) for the brilliant start to his promising career with Saint-Gobain. Each year, the prize is presented to a young graduate of the École Polytechnique whose first few years in industry have revealed a combination of technical skill, an aptitude for management and success in an international arena.
